DR. MED. SUSANNE VON DER HEYDT

Dr. Susanne von der Heydt began her studies in medicine in 1989 at the University of Verona and continued the same year at RWTH Aachen. She received her full medical license after the AIP in 1998 and completed her doctorate at Charité in Berlin in 1996, where she continued to work until 2020 and completed her speciality in pediatric surgery. During this time, she held many guest residencies in vascular anomaly centers, including with Prof. Peter Berlien at the Elisabeth Klinik in Berlin, Dr. Milton Waner and Dr. Teresa O in New York, Dr. Lutz Meyer in Eberswalde, and Prof. JC Lopez Gutierrez in Madrid. Since 2008, she was the head of the consultation for hemangiomas and vascular anomalies at the Pediatric Surgery Department of the Universitätsmedizin Charité Berlin.

From 2016 to 2018, she completed the master's program in Public Health at the Berlin School of Public Health, Charité.

She has been on the board of the Berlin Medical Association (Ärztekammer Berlin) since 2019 and their treasurer since 2021. She is also a member of the board at Marburger Bund Berlin-Brandenburg and became a member of KLUG (Climate Change and Health) in 2021.

In 2020 she opened her own practice in Berlin and recently adopted a senior research position at the University Medical Center Halle (Saale) with Prof. W. Wohlgemuth.
